

#### Sentence Pattern

Be Going to

We use "be going to + a base verb" to talk about future plans or intentions.



We usually put the negative form "not" after the be verb, e.g. We are not going to swim in the sea.

### Sentence Pattern 2

#### **Future Time Word**

"Tomorrow," "next," and "in + time" are words which express time in the future.

#### **Future**

tomorrow

tomorrow morning/afternoon/evening/night

next Monday/week/month/year

in...minute(s)/hour(s)/day(s)/week(s)

I'm going to visit my uncle tomorrow.

Eric is going to fly a kite tomorrow afternoon.

We are going to go to London next month.

The show is going to start in ten minutes.



Tip

We use the word "when" to ask about the time. For example, the question for "They are going to have a party tomorrow." is "When are they going to have a party?"





The present progressive can also show future plans. This is because some verbs such as come, go, do, start, and stay, can be used to show future time with the present progressive. For example, "Dad is coming home tomorrow" has the same meaning as "Dad is going to come home tomorrow."
