

Judy: No, I haven't, but I've read the book. I love the story.

Max: I have three free tickets. Shall we watch it with Mia tomorrow?


Judy: Wow! I'd love to. Who has given you the tickets?

Max: My aunt. Oh, I haven't seen Mia today. Is she still in school?

Judy: Yes, she is. Let's look for her later.



You use **have/has + past participle** (= p.p.) to talk about something that happened at an unknown time in the past but has an effect on the present.


