	2. Colorful Clothing	a brown hat, a white shirt, a pink skirt, a purple sweater, blue pants, red shoes, green shorts, yellow socks	What color is your <u>hat</u> ? My <u>hat</u> is <u>brown</u> . What color is <u>his/her shirt</u> ? His/Her <u>shirt</u> is <u>white</u> . What color are <u>his/her shorts</u> ? His/Her <u>shorts</u> are <u>green</u> .
2 Home, Sweet Home!	1. Around the House	bathroom, bedroom, dining room, kitchen, living room, study	Where are you? I'm in the <u>bedroom</u> . Where is <u>your mother</u> ? <u>She</u> is in the <u>kitchen</u> .
	2. At Home	taking a bath, sleeping, eating, cooking, watching TV, reading	What are you doing? I'm <u>cooking</u> in the <u>kitchen</u> . What is <u>your grandmother</u> doing? <u>She</u> is <u>eating</u> in the <u>dining room</u> .

	2. Having Fun!	feed the fish, fly a kite, play with friends, ride a bike, take a walk,	What can you do at the park? I can <u>ride a bike</u> at the park. What can <u>your mother</u> do at the park? <u>She</u> can <u>ride a bike</u> at the park.
4 In the Week	1. Days of the Week	Sunday, Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, Saturday	What day is today? It is <u>Monday</u> . Is it <u>Sunday</u> today? Yes, it is. No, it isn't. It's <u>Saturday</u> .
	2. Daily Schedule	chat with friends, go to school, play basketball, play the piano, study English, go swimming, see a movie	What do you do on <u>Monday</u> ? I <u>go to school</u> on <u>Monday</u> . What does <u>Jack</u> do on <u>Wednesday</u> ? <u>He plays the piano</u> on <u>Wednesday</u> .
