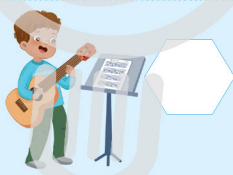

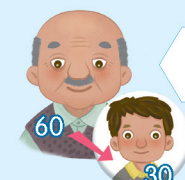

Materials

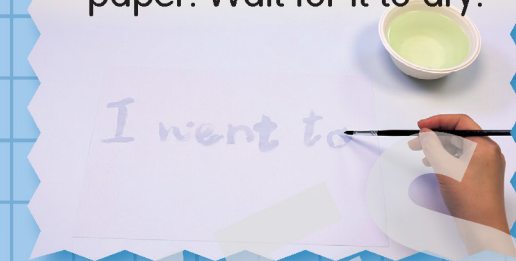


Steps

2 Use a paintbrush to write with the ink on the paper. Wait for it to dry.

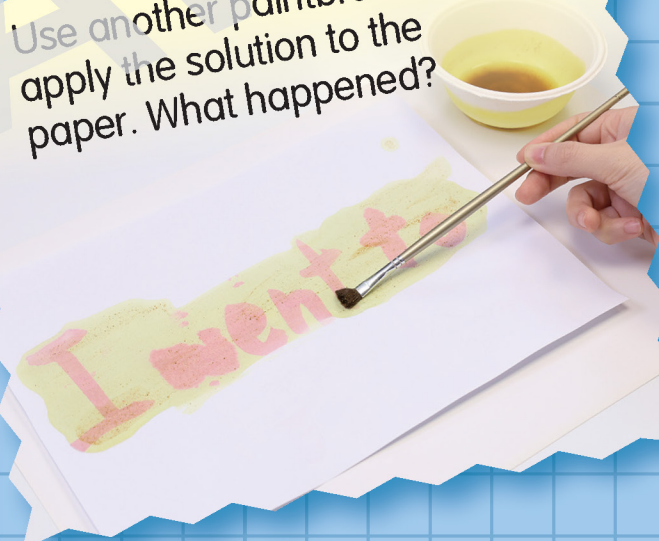

3 Mix turmeric and rubbing alcohol together in the bowl. Stir. This is your "color-changing solution."



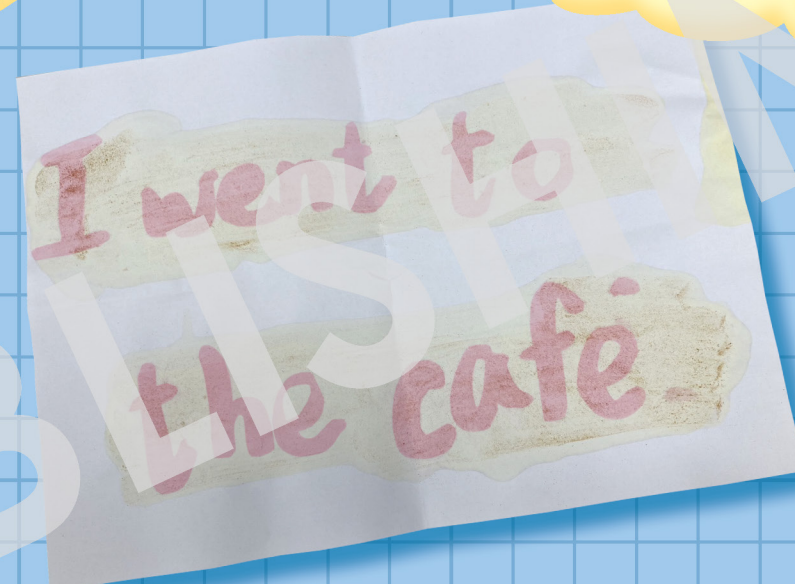
