



Gus is a red-eared slider turtle. He lives in a 20-gallon glass aquarium. The aquarium has a light on the top. The light keeps Gus warm. He likes to swim in his little pond, but he also has a dry place to stay. Gus eats bugs and plants. He is 10 inches long, and he will live for about 30 years.

Draco is a Children's python. He lives in an aquarium that is 4 feet, or 1.2 meters, long. One side of his home has a special light. It makes that side warmer, while the other side is colder. Draco eats rats. He is 3 feet, or 36 inches, long, and he can live for around 20 years.

These pets live a long time! Iris will love them for many years.



Upside Down Lab 1 Straw Rockets 18



Materials







Steps

- Cut a piece of paper into a rectangle that is 5cm wide and 20cm long.
- Pinch one end to make a nose. Tape it closed.




Blow into the straw to make it fly!



Wrap the paper around the straw, not too tight! Use the tape to keep it in place.



Cut out triangles to make fins and tape them to the back end. Feel free to draw on them if you like.
