


Review 1









Mystery Box

Materials:

- Paper
- Pen/pencil/crayons/eraser
- Small box/case/bag







Words:

Sentence patterns:

Q: What is it? A: It is a(n)...

Steps:

- Find a partner.
- Each student chooses five words and writes them on separate pieces of paper. Draw a picture for each word, too.





Fold the pieces of paper and put them into a box. Then shake it.



Student A selects a piece of paper, looks at it, and asks, "What is it?"



Student B guesses by saying, "It is a(n)..." If he/she is correct within five guesses, he/she gets the word. If he/she fails, Student A puts the word back into the box.



Ochange roles and repeat from Step 4. The first student who gets five words wins!
