

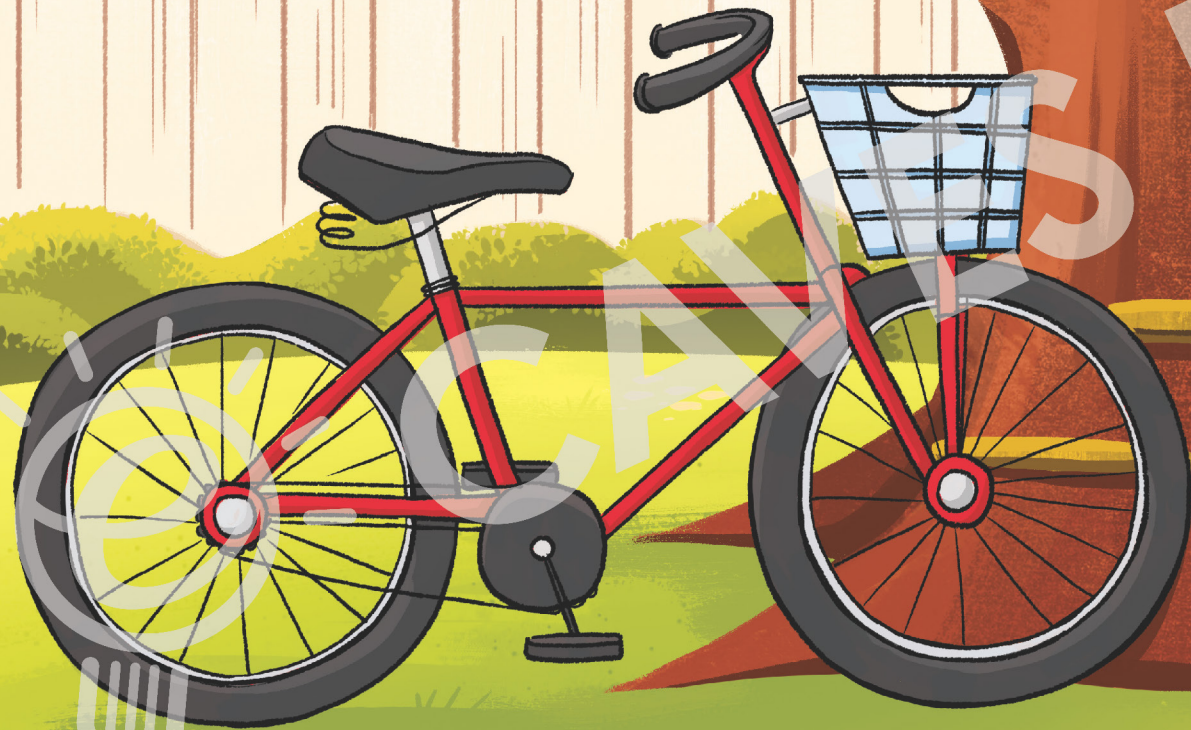


“Hello, Patrick,” says Spike.

The highest outdoor air temperature ever recorded on Earth is 56.7°C . This was taken in California's Death Valley National Park on July 10, 1913.
